The concept:

The artist has always been intrigued by an artist's conceptual process and to him, Chihuly's artform is a result of bringing his drawings to life. His 3D sculptures are beautiful, tactile, and larger than life expressions of what he puts first on paper. That is the inspiration for this design: taking Chihuly's 3D artform and reimagine it in a 2D graphic t-shirt. The design takes cues from his most iconic installations - the circular shapes and colours of *Float Boat*, and combining them to form a 2D graphic silhouette from his "Boat" series in front.
